

COMMISSIONERATE OF LABOUR

The Commissionerate of Labour is effectively enforcing various Central and State Labour Legislations with a greater focus on protecting the interests of the workers engaged in both organized and unorganized sectors. The department is implementing various labour legislations to maintain good industrial relations, protecting the welfare of workers, promoting social security and redress the grievances of consumers. The Commissionerate of Labour is functioning in the Tamil Nadu Labour Welfare Board Building at D.M.S. Compound, Teynampet, and Chennai-6. The Commissioner of Labour is the Head of the Department with three Additional Commissioners of Labour working to discharge administration, conciliation and legal metrology functions and two Joint Commissioners of Labour at the Head quarters. There are four Zonal Additional Commissioners of Labour and ten Regional Joint Commissioners of Labour who are entrusted with the implementation of various welfare Schemes for unorganized workers and enforcement of various Labour laws for organized workers and Quasi judicial functions within their respective territorial jurisdiction.

At the district level, Assistant Commissioners of Labour (Enforcement) are appointed to enforce the various Labour Legislations including the Legal Metrology Act. The Deputy Inspectors of Labour, Assistant Inspectors of Labour and Stamping Inspectors are enforcing the legislations at sub-district level. Conciliation Officers in the cadre of Deputy Commissioner of Labour / Assistant Commissioner of Labour are appointed in each district to settle industrial disputes.

The Plantations Labour Act, 1951 and its rules have been framed to provide for the welfare of the plantation labour and to regulate the conditions of work in plantations. The Additional Commissioner of Labour (Administration) / Chief Inspector of Plantations is supervising and monitoring the enforcement of Plantations Labour Act 1951. Chief Inspector of Plantations is assisted by ten Assistant Commissioners of Labour (Plantations) Ooty, Coonoor, Kothagiri, Gudalur, Panthalur, Valparai, Yercaud, Batlagundu, Theni and Nagercoil.

The offices of the two Assistant Surgeons (Plantation) are situated in Ooty and Nagercoil.

This Department from 1.4.2017 is taking various rehabilitative measures for rescued bonded labour.

The Assistant Commissioner of Labour (Women Welfare) enforce the Labour Legislations with particular reference to Women/Child Labour in establishments other than factories. The Assistant Commissioners of Labour (Women Welfare) have been notified as Inspectors under the various Labour Legislations, which apply to Women and Child Labour. The offices of these Assistant Commissioners of Labour (Women Welfare) are located in Chennai, Tirunelveli and Coimbatore.

Legal Metrology Act, 2009 and Rules

In order to protect the interest of the consumers, the Government of India have enacted the Legal Metrology Act, 2009 and the Legal Metrology (Packaged Commodities) Rules, 2011. The Tamil Nadu Government have also enacted The Tamil Nadu Legal Metrology (Enforcement) Rules, 2011. All the above Act and rules came into force with effect from 01.04.2011.

Legal Metrology Act, 2009

This act enforces standards of weights and measures and protects the interest of consumers and regulates trade and commerce in weights and measures and other goods which are sold or distributed by weight or measure or number and for matters connected therewith.

In case of using unstamped weight and measure and using non-standard measure the users are penalized.

License is being issued by the department for repairing, selling and manufacturing the weights and measures. Only the license holders can do the above work under the Legal Metrology Act.

Legal Metrology (Packaged Commodities) Rules, 2011

To protect the consumers interest the net weight of the packaged commodities is being checked by the Legal Metrology Officers and the penal action is being taken against the erring traders.

Under the Legal Metrology (Packaged Commodities) Rules all the Packers, Manufacturers, Importer selling the product for business have to get the registration certificate from the department.

Under the Legal Metrology (Packaged Commodities) Rules, 2011 the packages for sale shall contain the following declarations:-

1. Name and Full Address of the Manufacturer, Packer, Importer along with consumer care number and email address
2. Common or Generic name of the Commodity.
3. Net quantity in terms of Weight / Measures / Number.
4. Month & Year of manufacturing or packing.
5. Best before use by date.
6. Maximum Retail Price (Inclusive of all taxes)

To protect the consumers from being charged in excess MRP and for non-declaration on the packages the penal action is being taken against erring traders.

Ease of doing business

Registration Certificate and License under various labour Acts and Manufacturer, Dealer, Repairer license under the Legal Metrology Act and the Importer / Packer registration under the Legal Metrology (Packaged Commodities) Rules are being processed through online from July 2019 in the State.

TAMIL NADU LABOUR WELFARE BOARD

The Tamil Nadu Labour Welfare Board deals with the welfare of organized workers and maintains the Labour Welfare Fund under the Tamil Nadu Labour Welfare Fund Act 1972, which is applicable to all Factories, Plantations, Motor Transport Undertakings, Shops and Catering Establishments.

18 UNORGANISED WORKERS WELFARE BOARDS.

Tamil Nadu is a forerunner among the states in enacting a law for providing social security cover to the unorganised workers. The Tamil Nadu Manual Workers (Regulation of Employment and Conditions of Work) Act, 1982 and the schemes enacted therein provide social security schemes and welfare assistances to the Unorganised Workers, engaged in the 54 (Construction) + 69 (Manual) categories of employments specified in the schedule appended to the Act.

These schemes provide various welfare assistances to the unorganised registered workers such as Education, Marriage, Maternity, Natural Death, Accidental Death, Funeral, Accident Disability, Monthly Pension and Family Pension (Registered Construction Workers only).

Functions of Unorganised Workers Welfare Boards

At the District level 35 Assistant Commissioners of Labour (Social Security Scheme) administers the functions of the Boards such as Registration, Renewal and Disbursement of Welfare Scheme Assistance to the Unorganised Workers.

The Head Office and district offices of the unorganized welfare boards have been computerized for speedy compliance of claim application.

The Online registration process was initiated from 19.06.2020 and from 20.07.2020 onwards identity cards have been issued to the registered workers. The online renewal and claim application received from (26.08.2020) is verified by ACL (SSS) Concerned.

The District Monitoring Committee headed by the District Collector monitors the timely disbursement of benefits to the members.

In order to mitigate the sufferings of manual workers while receiving scheme assistance, the disbursement of welfare scheme assistances are directly transferred to the bank accounts of the beneficiaries/ unorganised workers through Electronic Clearance System (**ECS**) mode with greater transparency.

Source of Funds

The Tamil Nadu Construction Workers Welfare Board receives contribution at the rate of 1% of the total estimated cost of the building or the construction work proposed to be constructed. The contribution of **Rs.92.98** crore has been received upto **30.06.2021**

The Tamil Nadu Unorganised Drivers Welfare Board receives the additional tax collected for every commercial motor transport carrying passengers or goods on roads at the rate of 1% under the Tamil Nadu Motor Vehicle Taxation Act, 1974. An amount of **Rs.2,46,29,316/-** has been received as additional tax upto **30.06.2021**

Tamil Nadu Manual Workers Social Security and Welfare Board and other 15 Welfare Boards receive Government Grants for implementing welfare schemes. The Government of Tamil Nadu has allotted **Rs.215.64 Crore** for the financial year 2021-2022.

Details of Registration and Disbursement of Welfare Assurances Special initiatives

- ❖ With a view to extend the benefits of Social Security Scheme to the Interstate Migrant workers engaged in construction work, Tamil Nadu Government has been Pioneer in registering the Interstate Migrant workers. So far **24,274** Interstate Migrant Workers have been registered.
- ❖ The personal accident relief in case of death at worksite/ hospital of a registered/ unregistered construction worker was enhanced from Rs.1,00,000/- to Rs.5,00,000/-. Accidental death assistance of Rs.**1.72** crore has been disbursed to **36** beneficiaries upto 30.06.2021
- ❖ Provision of Health care facilities for the benefit of construction workers at their work sites through mobile health clinics in Chennai, Tiruvallur and Kancheepuram districts. As on 30.06.2021, **1,01,492** workers have been benefited.
- ❖ Providing transport facilities to the children of the construction workers staying at work sites to attend regular / SSA schools. So far **1,576** children were benefited.
- ❖ Dormitories have been constructed for temporary accommodation to the construction workers with all facilities. Ezhichur dormitory was inaugurated by Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu on 04.03.2017 and Thaiyur B Village dormitory through Video Conferencing on 05.04.2018. Dormitory at Ezhichur Village was functioning from **17.06.2019**. Upto 31.10.2020, **607** construction workers were accommodated in the dormitory. At present Ezhichur dormitory is taken up by the Kancheepuram District Administration for accommodating Covid-19 patients and also the Thaiyur B village Dormitory is taken up by the Chengelpet District Administration for accommodating Covid-19 patients. In Thaiyur B village Dormitory,

for providing drinking water facilities the pipe laying works are being carried out by PWD from **28.10.2020** and is under process.

- ❖ To simplify the procedure of registration, renewal and to extend the welfare scheme assistances to the beneficiaries, integrated software was started at a cost of **Rs.1.05 crore**. To remit the cess amount payable to the Tamil Nadu Construction Workers Welfare Board is under process. Now online registration facility has been started from **19.06.2020** and renewal/claim facility has been started from **26.08.2020**. Integrated Software with the line departments to the portal is under process. Upto **30.06.2021**, **2,83,777** unorganised workers have been registered through online.
- ❖ The Government has issued order vide G.O.(Ms.) No.196, Labour and Employment (I2) Department, Dated.17.11.2017 to enhance natural death assistance from Rs.15,000 to Rs.20,000 and funeral expenses from Rs.2,000 to Rs.5,000. Upto 30.06.2021, **7,681** beneficiaries have been benefited.
- ❖ The Government has enhanced Family Pension assistance to registered Construction Workers from Rs.400/- to Rs.500/- vide G.O. (Ms.) No.96, Labour and Employment (I2) Department, Dated.09.08.2018. Upto 30.06.2021 **Rs.11,00,900/-** have been disbursed.
- ❖ Providing food at free of cost at Amma Canteen to the registered construction workers employed in Chennai district. Upto 30.06.2021, **1,65,491** registered Construction workers have been benefited.
- ❖ Government issued orders vide G.O. (Ms.) No.14, Labour and Employment (I1) Department, Dated. 31.01.2017 to provide school and hostel fees to the outstanding children studying in Government school from 6th to 12th standard of construction workers so as to pursue their education in private schools. In the Academic year of 2018-19, 2019-20 and 2020-21, **158** Children were admitted and **Rs.50,21,460/-** has been released.
- ❖ Safety Kit consisting of Shoes, Helmet, Reflective Jackets, Hand Gloves and Goggles at a cost of **Rs.5.44** crore have been distributed to **25,000** construction workers.

- ❖ Providing Personal protective equipments to 1,00,000 construction workers, based on the announcement 2020-21, the Government accorded permission to sanction the amount of Rs.21.39 Crores vide G.O.(Ms.)No.97, Labour and Employment (I2) Department, Dated. 14.05.2020. Necessary arrangements to issue safety kits to workers is under process.
- ❖ (PM-SYM) The Hon'ble Prime Minister of India launched and dedicated Pradhan Mantri Shram-Yogi Maandhan (PM-SYM) on 5th March 2019, a Pension Scheme for Unorganised Sector Workers in Ahmedabad, Gujarat. In Tamil Nadu, so far **56,800** workers have been registered under this pension scheme.
- ❖ During the **Covid-19** period **Dry Ration Kits** were disbursed to Registered construction workers, unregistered ISM Construction Workers through DISH, RLC, Greater Chennai Corporation. Tamil Nadu Unorganised Drivers and unregistered ISM Drivers were also distributed with Dry Ration Kits. A total number of **16,82,577** Unorganised workers were benefited at the cost of **Rs.106,17,06,087/-** and During COVID-19, Financial Assistance of Rs.1000/-disbursed to registered unorganized workers of 17 Welfare Boards. As a first spell Rs.1000/- was disbursed to **23,16,067** registered unorganized workers to a tune of **Rs.231,60,67,000/-**.As a II spell Rs.1000/- was disbursed to **23,13,957** registered unorganized workers to a tune of **Rs.231,39,57,000/-**. As III spell of Rs.1000/- was disbursed to **1,30,021** registered unorganized workers to a tune of **Rs.13,00,21,000/-** of Chennai and certain parts of Chengalpattu, Tiruvallur and Kancheepuram Districts. Totally **Rs.476,00,45,000/-** was released from the funds of 17 Unorganised Workers Welfare Boards towards Covid-19.
- ❖ The Government vide G.O. (Ms.) No.195, Labour and Employment (I2) Department, Dated **24.11.2020** has ordered for distribution of Pongal Gift Hamper containing Raw Rice, Moong Dhal, Edible Oil, Ghee, Jaggery, Cardamom, Cashew Nuts and Raisins at a cost of **Rs.57,12,97,500/-** from Tamil Nadu Civil Supplies Corporation and **5,88,920** Dhothy and Angavasthram for male workers, **6,80,630** Sarees for Female workers at a cost of **Rs.37,27,50,490/-** from Tamil Nadu Handloom Weavers Co-Operative Society Limited (Co-Optex) Pongal Gift Hampers were given to the

registered Construction Workers and Pensioners through District Assistant Commissioner of Labour (SSS).

- ❖ The Government have accorded administrative sanction for Developing Arasu Smart Labour App for the benefit of Unorganised Workers and the Public vide G.O. (Ms.) No.108, Labour and Employment (I1) Department, Dated.02.07.2020. The Government has accorded financial sanction of Rs.30 Lakhs (Rs. Thirty Lakhs Only) for developing this App and the work is under process.
- ❖ The Government have accorded administrative sanction for Developing Amma Drivers App for the benefit of Unorganised Drivers and the Public vide G.O. (Ms.) No.109, Labour and Employment (I1) Department, Dated.02.07.2020. The Government has accorded financial sanction of Rs.30 Lakhs (Rs. Thirty Lakhs Only) for developing this App and the work is under process.
- ❖ The Government have accorded administrative sanction for Distribution of Safety Kit Box to protect the welfare of Unorganised Drivers vide G.O. (Ms.) No.115, Labour and Employment (I1) Department, Dated.22.07.2020. The Unorganized Drivers have been facilitated with a Safety Kit Box worth of Rs.2000/- distributed to 20,000 registered Unorganised drivers which contains Uniform, Shoes, First Aid Box and Fire Extinguisher.
- ❖ Providing Covid-19 vaccination to 2,00,000 construction workers in co-ordination with the TNMSC at a cost of Rs.13 crore from the funds of Tamil Nadu Construction Workers Welfare Board. The Vaccination Camp has been inaugurated by Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu on 25.06.2021.
- ❖ The Hon'ble Chief Minister has inaugurated the distribution of welfare scheme assistance of Rs.34.78 Crore to 50,000 unorganised workers in Chennai on 30.07.2021 and welfare scheme assistance have also been disbursed in 35 districts.

TAMILNADU INSTITUTE OF LABOUR STUDIES

The Tamilnadu Institute of Labour Studies was established in the year 1973. It was registered under the Tamilnadu Societies Registration Act, 1975 on 8.10.1987 and started functioning as an autonomous body with effect from 1.4.1988. This institute is run on Grant-in-aid provided by the Government. The Institute is being administered by the Governing Committee under the Chairmanship of the Hon'ble Minister for Labour Welfare and Skill Development Department.

This Institute is conducting academic courses i.e. B.A. (Labour Management -3 years) and M.A. (Labour Management – 2 years) affiliated to the University of Madras. The Institute is also conducting a part time (evening) one year P.G. Diploma Course called “Post Graduate Diploma in Labour Administration” (PGDLA) and “Diploma in Labour Laws with Administrative Law (week end) (D.L.L.) for the benefit of the working persons. The University of Madras has recognized this Institute as a Research Institute to conduct both part time and full time Ph.D. programmes on Labour Management from the year 2001 onwards.

This Institute periodically conducts Training Programmes, Seminars, Refresher Courses, Orientation Programmes, etc. to cater to the needs of the persons employed in private / public sectors, trade unions and the officials of the Labour Department and the Directorate of Industrial Safety and Health.

This institute also conducts programmes in collaboration with the International Labour Organisation (ILO), New Delhi and V.V. Giri National Labour Institute, Noida.

The Government has allotted three acres of land for construction of own building at Ambattur I.T.I. campus for Tamilnadu Institute of Labour Studies. The Government has sanctioned an amount of Rs.15 crores and given administrative permission and financial sanction vide G.O. (Ms) No.227 dt. 25.11.2016 of the Labour and Employment (G2) Department for construction of own building at Ambattur I.T.I. campus with Administrative Block and Hostel Block. Office shifted to New Building and is functioning at Ambattur from 22.3.2021.

TAMIL NADU ACADEMY OF CONSTRUCTION

“Tamil Nadu Academy of Construction (TAC)” has been established to enhance the skill, ability and knowledge of the workers employed in the construction work as per G.O.No.24 Labour and Employment (G2) Department, Dated.04.01.2013.

Training were given to 785 Construction Workers through the Technical Training Centres recognized by Industrial Training Institutes approved by the Directorate of Employment and Training (DET) under Modular Employable skill training programme.

The Training is provided free of cost. On successful completion of training, National Council for Vocational Training (NCVT) certificates are issued to the trainees.

As per G.O.(MS).No.30 Labour and Employment (S2) Department Dated:08.03.2017 Tamil Nadu Construction Workers Welfare Board has allotted Rs.6 crore to the Tamil Nadu Skill Development Corporation for conducting training programme to the construction workers in collaboration with TAC. One day training was given to Construction Workers and their wards in their respective trades like Masonry, Electrician, Painting and Carpentry and their knowledge is being assessed by Construction Industry Development Council (CIDC) officials with related trades, and after that certificates were issued. So far 43,000 construction workers have been imparted training.

More over by G.O.(MS).No.163 Labour and Employment (C) Department Dated:09.09.2019 Bridge Course Training under Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) concept for three days at the cost of Rs.186.20 lakhs to 5,000 Construction Workers, funded by Tamil Nadu Construction Workers Welfare Board has also been taken up. Tamil Nadu Academy of Construction in co-ordination with Tamil Nadu Skill Development Corporation (TNSDC) and Construction Industry Development Council (CIDC) is being carried out successfully. So for 2005 Construction workers have been imparted training.
